THE CAUCUS MEETING of the Mayor and Council was called to order by Mayor Larson at 4:30pm at the Borough Hall, on East 7th Street. He stated that adequate notice of this meeting has been provided in accordance with the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Act by posting a copy of the notice of this meeting on the bulletin board in the Borough Hall on January 4, 2013 and by mailing a copy of the notice to the Beach Haven Times and Asbury Park Press, newspapers designated by Mayor and Council on January 4, 2013, to receive such notice, and by filing a copy of the notice with the Borough Clerk on January 4, 2013.

Mayor Larson asked if anyone had anything for caucus. Dottie Reynolds wanted to speak about a new type of walkway. Scott explained that they are rubber industrial mats and 22 foot long is \$493.00. It is worth trying. It weighs 136 pounds. It is \$600.00 cheaper than the blue stuff we got. Dottie said there is no other wood product that is satisfactory. Dave was concerned that we would be sued if we continue to use what we have been ordering. Scott said we can drag it if we need to. Scott said we have only had one entry for the Battle of the Bands so he asked if we could just hire the one band that did apply and let them play one night. All agreed. Mayor Larson mentioned the FEMA maps. Frank Mikuletzky said there is a real high tide, called a King Tide on the 25th. ADOPTION HEARING 2013 BUDGET AMENDMENT:

Marilyn Wasilewski asked why the increase in the budget. Kat entered the meeting. Reason is to support the debt service payment and to cover some of the things that went over 2%. \$444,580 was the increase. Spark moved to close, seconded by Reynolds and carried by all.

Gail read the budget adoption resolution. Warr moved to adopt, seconded by Mikuletzky and carried by all. Thus the 2013 budget was adopted.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

WATER/SEWER: Michael Spark updated everyone on the progress of the water tower. We should be drinking our own water by July 1. The fabric is off now and they are doing welding and when that is finished they will roll the final coat of paint. It has been primed. Ed said he estimated the water usage due to the water tower. The pump is running 24/7 to keep the pressure up.

PUBLIC SAFETY: Frank Mikuletzky asked to make the court report a part of the minutes and said we did well with our monies from court this time. There are still copper thefts going on down south and Frank warned of computer and phone scams. If you don't call them you shouldn't be giving them anything.

DOCKS AND HARBORS: Dave Bossi said we have one more boat slip to rent and we keep #1 to rent out on a weekly basis. Mayor mentioned that Great Lakes Dredging is leasing out the end of 16th Street.

BEACHES AND PARKS: Dottie Reynolds said beach badge sales are down. Kay at the booth thinks we are now up since this report. Tennis is down by \$538.00. Bay beach Fencing has been installed. Train will be replaced soon. Guards are all on duty. Surcharge of \$1.00 if buy on beach. We have let the sand build up on the entrances to the beach. You will have a little climb at the South end of town which the North end has been having for years. 29th street will be cleared this week and in the fall a new Handicap entrance will be built. We now angle fencing to the South East. Watch out for the Piping Plover and watch out for turtles in the road way.

FINANCE: George Warr we just adopted the budget. He mentioned what money on the bill list stays in town and what goes out. \$569,000 in bills and \$254,000 stays in Barnegat Light to run the town.

PUBLIC WORKS: Scott Sharpless said Public Works has been very busy and that they are doing a great job. We are having a week by week work schedule along with all the usual jobs. We meet every Friday and go over the list. Partimers are in for the summer. They blew out the ramp at the docks. Gazebo Lighting has been tweaked. The 4th of July Parade is Sunday, the 7th of July. Lineup is 6:30PM behind the old Borough Hall. There is no specific theme - just Americana. Trophies will be given out to the kids only. Matt Avery, the one man band will be the first concert on July 11th. He is from Key West and is really good. It will be at 7:30pm.

On a motion by Reynolds, seconded by Sharpless and carried by all the public session was opened. Tom Stiles began by talking about the Ordinance for the 3 million. Cricket Luker asked permission for her dog show on August 13 at 4:30pm and would like permission to close 5th street during the event. She asked about Dog Art at the Dog Park. They did something similar at the Shelter. What about the outside. Could it be double sided. What about cats? Scott thought it would be better if it were double sided. Next there was a motion for permission for the Dog show. Spark moved to do so, seconded by Reynolds and carried by all. Reynolds moved to allow the Dog Art, seconded by Spark and carried by all. Jim and Janice Gibson who live at 15th and Seaview came to ask the council's help in the home next to them. The home is rented year round to large parties, proms, etc. and they are experiences many problems. Loud noise into the wee hours, parking in the easement and in his driveway, trash and recycling all over the place to name a few. Kids are sleeping on the roof. The man's website says rented by owner at the end of a private owner and a private catwalk to the beach. It said they are paving the parking area on the west side of the house. He complained of them cutting down trees. He said they took down a nice dune. They were instructed to file a civil action. They did say that the police and the town always respond to them, but it still has not helped the situation. His complaints were many, but they are not things that the council can take care of in most instances. This goes on all winter long. Gail asked if he filed police reports. He said he put a cable across the driveway. Someone keeps cutting the cable. Scott said he has been watching the fence situation on 16th Street from the catwalk. Dottie said we should be able to fine the owner. Dick Feehan asked if we had an animal house rule? We do not. Dick lives on 15th Street and says it is very noisy, etc. George Warr asked if we can do anything regarding Zoning. They do Fireworks and anything else said Dick Feehan. Scott said there is a big party zone in the dunes on 16th street all the time. The cops can't catch them. Marilyn said you have to go to the owner. Give him fines. Terry said you cannot regulate who is in the house. Maybe some occupancy limitation. Kat said to file a formal complaint as they do in Ship Bottom, against the property owner. You need pictures, etc. You must file the complaint. Mayor said we will get on the walkway thing. Scott said get your neighbors to join in as well. Tom said the town is always there when they have called. Mayor said the guy can improve his yard. George Warr said we have to give this man some relief. There being no further comment, on a motion by Warr, seconded by Reynolds and carried by all the public session was closed.

The clerk read the above by title and number and the Mayor asked for a motion to open public hearing on same. Warr moved to open, seconded by Reynolds and carried by all. Tom Stiles asked what we planned to do with the land if we got it. Why is the Ordinance for \$3000,000? Are we willing to pay that much. Mayor and Scott explained our thoughts. Tom felt we had enough open space. What about maintenance? Mayor said we are dealing with open lands here. Tom said he heard the open space recommended this and if all the councilmen are for it. Marilyn Wasilewski did not think we need more open space, we need ratables. John Alchus was in favor of the town purchasing the property. Dottie Reynolds said people value the lower density and the it is quieter. Tom said a miniature golf course that may go in on Broadway is not Barnegat Light. Mayor said the Open Lands Committee voted unanimously to go for it. Steve Rabbitt said it was voted on by all to get it if we can afford it. Dick Malacrea also said it is a good idea. It cost more for every house that was built. What about school taxes? Ratables in Stafford Township are way down. Stafford just got a 5 million loan - to keep your ratable stable. Kat said there is no guarantee that we will spend any of the money. Vince asked if it is a sealed bid. It is an online auction. Tom Stiles said the Government never paid taxes on the property. He said there are 13 lots. No one has looked at it at all as far as we know. Mayor said we need to have a chance. Gail said the opening bid is \$100,000.00 dollars. \$25,000 must be put down to bid. Warr made a motion to close the public session, seconded by Reynolds and carried by all.
