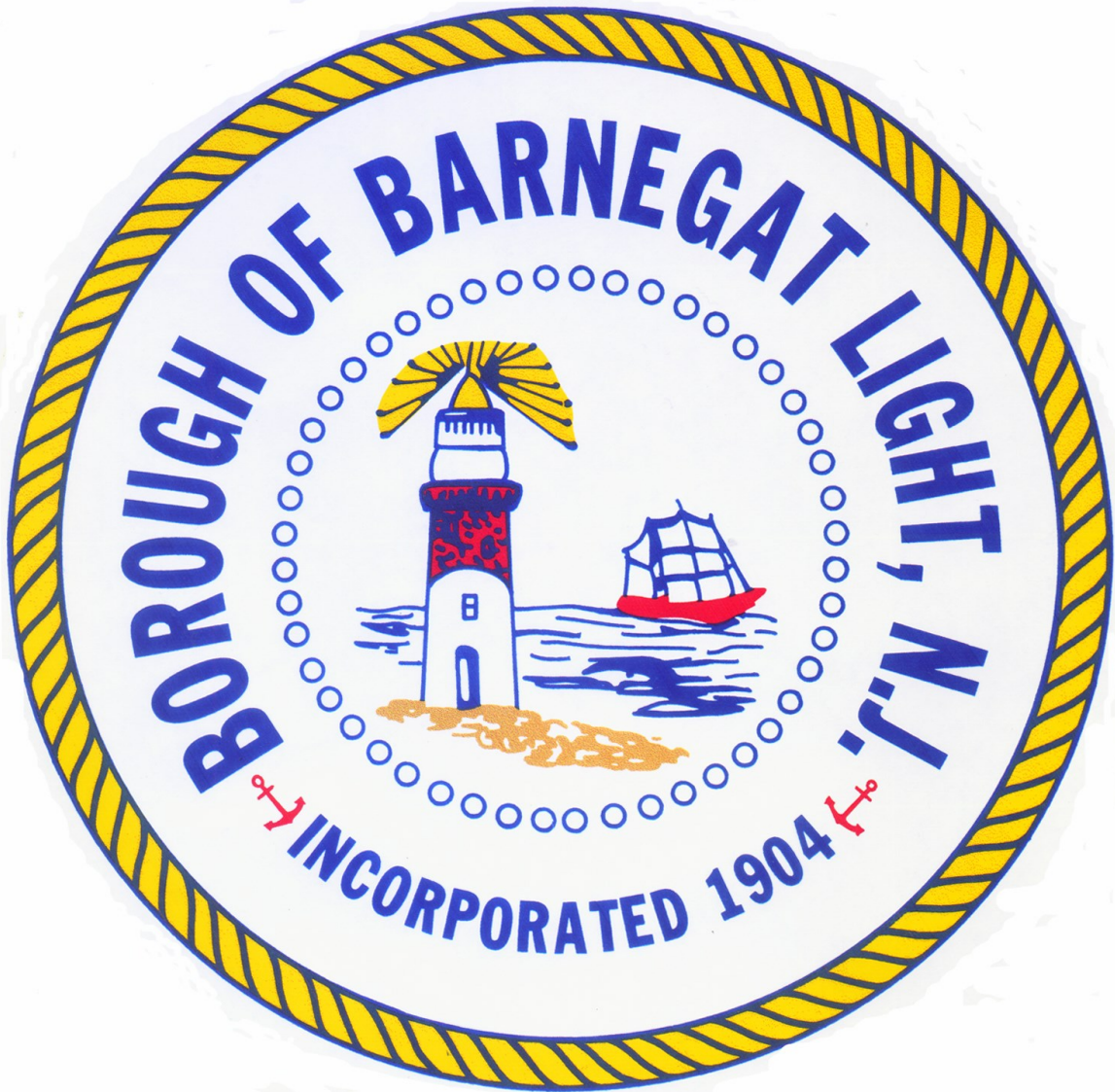

Beach Badges-

Beach Badges are required by all persons, 12 and over, who are on the beach. Badges are required from June 20th through September 7th between the hours of 10:00AM and 5:00PM.

Fees:

Season Badges are on sale from mid-November until June 5th at the PreSeason price of \$40, after June 5th the season badge cost is \$50.00

Weekly Badges are \$25.00 and are good from Saturday to Friday

Daily Badges are \$10.00

Senior Badges are \$12.00 for any person 65 years or older, ID must be shown as proof of age for all senior badge purchases

All beach badge purchases are final- NO RETURNS, NO REFUNDS



Beach Tram-

For beach patrons between 4th & 9th St. the Borough offers a Beach Tram service. The tram picks up beachgoers on the street end, on the beach, and takes them to the nearest lifeguarded area. It operates the same hours as the lifeguards, 10:00AM to 5:00PM, it does not operate from 1:00PM to 2:00PM. Last pick-up to leave the beach is around 4:45PM.



Boat Ramp-

The ramp is located at 10th & Bayview

Fees:

Daily Pass - \$25.00 per vessel (including jet skis)

Weekly Pass- \$75.00

Season Pass- \$150.00 per vessel (including jet skis)

Commercial Season Pass- \$250.00



Pickle Ball Courts-

The Pickle Ball Courts have been a great asset to our recreation area on West 10th St. The courts are open to both residents and non-residents from 8:00AM until dusk seven days a week. ALL players must have a current pickleball pass- annual, weekly or daily. Passes are free for Barnegat Light resident & the cost for non-residents is as follows: \$100 for an annual pass, \$20 for a weekly pass and \$5 for a daily pass. Court space is limited, so please be courteous if others are waiting to play.



Tennis Courts-

The tennis courts are public courts and can be used by anyone. ALL players must have a current Barnegat Light **season** beach badge. If you do not have a beach badge the charge will be \$10 per hour. Reservations are recommended, Barnegat Light residents can make reservations two weeks in advance and all others one week in advance. The courts are open 8:00AM until 6:00PM seven days a week.

*Prior to the start of the season- Barnegat Light residents can sign-up for one court at a set day and time weekly for the entire season. All players must have their **season** badge to sign up. This **MUST** be done by **June 5th**.



Skate Park-

The Skate Park is open daily from 9:00AM until 6:00PM (or dusk, whichever comes first). All skaters must have a, helmet, elbow pads & kneepads. No bicycles or scooters permitted in the park.



Beach Wheels-

Beach wheels are available to be lent out to any beach patron who is unable to walk to the beach or on the beach. For more information, call the Borough Hall at 609-494-9196 Monday through Friday between 8:00AM and 3:30PM



Dogs-

All dogs must be licensed and leashed. Dogs are allowed on the beach, on a leash from September 30th until April 15th.

Dog Park

The ball field on West 10th Street is also a Dog Park. It's a great place for dogs to run free and play. There is a separate area for small dogs. All dog park users **MUST** obtain a dog park gate entry fob ("Paw Pass"). Passes are free for Barnegat Light residents and for non-residents the annual fee is \$30 and the weekly fee is \$15. The cost for a replacement fob (for everyone) if lost is \$15. Applications for the passes can be obtained at Borough Hall, the Recreation Booth (in season) or on the Borough website. Proof of rabies must be shown, either with a rabies certificate or a current dog license. Applications must be filled out & signed by the registered dog owner. Also, all dogs must be friendly & non-aggressive. Please be sure to clean-up after your dog!



Driveways-

Driveways need to be designated; you may not use your entire property front as a driveway. You can designate a minimum of 10 feet and a maximum of 20 feet, the remainder of your property front may be used for public street parking.



Parking-

There will be no parking on Central Ave. between June 1st and October 1st. And, no parking of trailers overnight (12AM-5AM) on any streets all year-round.



Lending Library-

The Borough has a small lending library, located in the Community Room at the Borough Hall on East 7th St. Want something to read or do you want to pass along some books you have already read? Stop by and visit our library. Bring a book, take a book, or both. Also, the Taxpayers' Association has two small book boxes outside of the Post Office on West 10th St., one box is for children's books and the other is for adult books.

“Pave the Pavilion”-

Recycling-

2026 Recycling Schedules & Guidelines were mailed out to all residents in November. Additional copies & the required stickers are available at the Borough Hall & the Recreation Booth (in season) on West 10th Street. The schedule & guidelines are also on the Borough website. TVs, computers, monitors & laptops cannot go in the garbage, these items must be taken to the Recycling Center in Manahawkin, all other electronics go in the garbage. You **must** make special arrangements for items with Freon (refrigerators/freezers & air conditioners), white goods (washers, dryers, hot water heaters, etc.) & metal items to be picked up, these items are only picked up certain days during the month. Please remember, NO plastic bags in the recycling! Any recycling that is not put out properly WILL NOT be picked up. Call the Borough Hall for more information &/or to schedule a pick-up for the above-mentioned items, Monday-Friday 8:00AM to 3:30PM, 609-494-9196. Please remember recycling is not voluntary, it's the law! Check the Garbage & Recycling tab under departments on the Borough website for County-wide Document Shredding & Household Hazardous Waste events.



Get Past Plastic-

New Jersey continues to ban plastic, single-use carry-out bags & polystyrene foam food service products. Plastic Single-Use bags are no longer available in stores. Paper Single-Use bags cannot be used in stores over 2500 square feet. Be sure to bring your own bag on your next trip to the store.
